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Comments for Public Posting: At PATH, we're committed to addressing both the symptoms and causes of our homelessness crisis. That's why we founded our PATH Ventures arm, to develop and build more affordable housing throughout LA and all of California. Since 2007, we've built 14 affordable, supportive housing developments statewide, with 16 more in the pipeline, for a total of nearly 2,000 units. We're proud of the progress we've made, often in partnership with City staff here in LA – but as everyone on this committee knows, we need much more affordable housing to meet this moment of crisis. We're heartened to see the Housing Element reckon with the City's current zoning strengths and shortfalls, and we look forward to working with City and Council staff on creative ways to increase the City's housing stock in the neighborhoods that need it the most. Homes end homelessness. By constructing more housing of all types across LA, we're not only fostering diverse and thriving communities – we're building places for everyone, including our most vulnerable neighbors, to call home.
