Comments for Public Posting: I've lived in the Westchester Playa neighborhood since 1986 and graduated from Westchester High School 52 years ago so I am intimately aware of our neighborhood. Would it be crazy to think that the planning department within its Housing Element could respect our single-family neighborhoods while also complying with the RHNA requirements? As an active member of our Preserve Westchester group, we beg you to reconsider the massive upzoning that's been proposed in the most recent Community Plan Update of April 2023. Of particular concern are the 66 million annual passengers who travel through our neighborhood to enjoy the offerings of our Greater Los Angeles. Of additional concern is the extensive traffic that Westchester feels due to LAX International Airport. How they will be able to enjoy the benefits that Los Angeles has to offer if they cannot get out of our neighborhood is of imperative concern. I urge the Planning Committee to reconsider their proposal BEFORE the story map is released by City Planning in December 2023 so that our community's residential properties are protected from upzoning when the plan goes to environmental review (EIR) in January 2024.
