Summary: The Sherman Oaks Neighborhood Council (SONC) supports CF 22-0002-S102, Resolution to address: Reproductive and Abortion Rights. This Resolution encourages our Federal Govt. to take actions within their authority to ensure care remains available to people who can become pregnant in need of reproductive care including abortion. These actions include but are not limited to: · Urging President Biden to issue an executive order directing the federal government to develop a national plan defending American's reproductive rights, including the right to an abortion; and direct the leaders of every federal agency to explore options to protect abortion rights, including: · the use of federal property and resources to increase abortion access such that reproductive care and abortions can occur on those properties and be exempt from the state's abortion laws; On May 9, 2022, the Sherman Oaks Neighborhood Council (SONC) approved a motion supporting the City Council's advocacy for reproductive rights. SONC continues to support these efforts to ensure pregnant people's rights to privacy and autonomy in making health care decisions regarding reproductive care, including pregnancy termination / abortion. SONC recognizes these rights are currently protected under California state law and that it is imperative for them to be provided greater protection by our federal government.
