WHEREAS, Pentatonix was formed in 2011 in Los Angeles with the dream of becoming the first mainstream a cappella group in modern times; and

WHEREAS, Pentatonix is a five-member a cappella group that gained fame from winning NBC TV's a cappella singing competition, *The Sing Off*; and

WHEREAS, Pentatonix is named after the pentatonic scale, which includes five notes per octave representing the five members of the group; and

WHEREAS, Pentatonix proudly represents various communities in Los Angeles, including the Latine, Black, and LGBTQ+ communities; and

WHEREAS, Pentatonix embarked on their first national headlining tour in the fall of 2012, which sold out and spanned 30 cities; and

WHEREAS, Pentatonix has earned three GRAMMY Awards, including Best Arrangement, Instrumental or A Cappella in both 2015 and 2016 and Best Country Duo/Group Performance with Dolly Parton in 2017; and

WHEREAS, Pentatonix assisted in times of national crisis by using their public profile to promote the White House's COVID Booster Campaign; and

WHEREAS, Pentatonix returned to Hollywood by performing at the Hollywood Bowl, which celebrated its 100th anniversary on September 29, 2022; and


WHEREAS, Pentatonix will release its sixth holiday studio album, *Holidays Around the World*, on October 28, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Pentatonix filmed a holiday unscripted special, "Pentatonix: Around the World for the Holidays" in Los Angeles, which will air on Disney+ in December 2022; and


WHEREAS, the City of Los Angeles will honor Pentatonix with a star on the Walk of Fame in Hollywood in February 2023:
