RESOLUTION

Dr. JSM "Bobby" Sarma

WHEREAS, Dr. JSM "Bobby" Sarma is a distinguished scientist whose contributions to the arena of health care have been transformational. While in India, he earned his doctoral degree in physics, with an emphasis in quantum mechanics; and

WHEREAS, after coming to the United States, he worked in cardiovascular research under an esteemed professor of cardiology from the University of Southern California. While there, he and his wife, a cardiologist, developed the Sarma formula, which calculates the QT interval at any heart rate. This formula has been used in pacemakers and other medical devices designed to measure this important electrophysiologic variable; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Sarma later worked at the City of Hope Medical Center in the Department of Cardiology as a research scientist and scientific advisor. He has over 60 publications, over 40 invited presentations, and innumerable requests for expert consultation; and

WHEREAS, because of his scholarly activity in the field of cardiovascular medicine, he was invited to become a Fellow of the American College of Cardiology. The rare combination of physics, applied mathematics, and physiology is embodied by Dr. Sarma's contributions to health care research; and

WHEREAS, in the later part of his career, he joined the Veterans Administration Hospital in Los Angeles as a faculty member of the Institutional Review Board. At the time, the VA sought to radically improve its human research practices and Dr. Sarma was brought on as part of the team to reshape the program; and

WHEREAS, he has since functioned as the Director of Research Mentorship and has helped countless junior and senior physicians with their peer-reviewed publications. He has punctuated his career as a recognized authority on research regulatory practices, statistical design, and health education. Dr. Sarma retired on December 31, 2021 and resides in Pasadena, CA with his wife:
