After completing the call for service, Mr. McGarry, his coworker, and the service clients remained at the scene for several minutes and were soon after approached by a person who attempted to rob the service clients. Without warning, the suspect turned and fired a single fatal gunshot at Mr. McGarry. The suspect remains unidentified. Detectives are continuing to investigate this crime, but have not been able to identify any suspect or suspects. Detectives believe a reward may compel members of the public to provide information on the person or persons responsible for this crime. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles; therefore, it is appropriate for the City of Los Angeles to offer a reward for information leading to the identification, apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for this crime.
