Instruct the Department of City Planning, in coordination with the Department of Building and Safety and City Attorney, to continue with instructions 1 AND 2, ~~and 3~~ of the PLUM Committee report for CF 22-0120-S1 dated June 18, 2024 as adopted by the City Council on July 2, 2024.

**Amend Instruction 1 June 18, 2024 , 2024 PLUM Committee Report to read:**

#1) Instruct DCP, in coordination with DBS and City Attorney to prepare and present an ordinance to amend Chapters 1 (Current Zoning Code) and 1A (New Zoning Code) of the LAMC to appropriately define electric vehicle charging as a primary use citywide and include standards for ministerial and discretionary approvals for such use in appropriate zones. Clear performance standards should maintain scalability and flexibility through alternative options, and consider community benefits and Citywide Design Guideline goals, for light, medium and heavy duty vehicles, including private fleet charging,...
