Subject: **SUPPLEMENTAL CITY SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES AND THE LOS ANGELES SPORTS AND ENTERTAINMENT COMMISSION RELATING TO SUPER BOWL LVI**

RECOMMENDATION

That the Council approve, and authorize the Mayor to execute, the Supplemental City Services Agreement between the City and the Los Angeles Sports and Entertainment Commission relating to Super Bowl LVI events with estimated compensation of \$4,216,404, subject to the submission of applicable insurance documents to the Office of the City Administrative Officer's Risk Management Division, and subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.

SUMMARY

The Mayor's Office requests approval to execute the proposed Supplemental City Services Agreement (Agreement) with the Los Angeles Sports and Entertainment Commission (LASEC; Contractor), a California non-profit corporation. The purpose of the Agreement is to provide supplemental City services relating to Super Bowl LVI events taking place within the City of Los Angeles during the two weeks preceding the Super Bowl LVI Game. The event locations include the Los Angeles Convention Center, JW Marriott LA Live, InterContinental Hotel, Hudson Lofts, and the Academy Museum of Motion Pictures. The game itself is being held in the City of Inglewood on February 13, 2022. The Agreement provides compensation estimated at \$4,216,404 and a term commencing January 30, 2022 through June 30, 2022. The requested City services under this Agreement include Police Department law enforcement services (\$3,860,000), Fire Department inspection and liaison services (\$201,904), and Department of Transportation traffic management services (\$154,500).

LASEC agrees to indemnify the City and provide insurance at its own expense related to the services under the Agreement. The recommendation in this report is subject to the submission of applicable insurance documents to the Office of the City Administrative Officer's Risk Management Division. In accordance with California Government Code section 53069.8, Council approval is required to provide supplemental law enforcement services to private entity-sponsored special events.

FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT

The Agreement provides reimbursement of actual costs for supplemental City services provided by the Police, Fire, and Transportation departments in support of Super Bowl LVI events. Total General Fund revenue is anticipated to be \$4,216,404.

FINANCIAL POLICIES STATEMENT

As compensation is provided to support the actual expenditures for departments under the Agreement in the current year, the recommendation of this report complies with the City's Financial Policies.

SUPPLEMENTAL CITY SERVICES AGREEMENT
between
THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES
and
THE LOS ANGELES SPORTS & ENTERTAINMENT COMMISSION

This Supplemental City Services Agreement (“Agreement”) is entered into by and between the City of Los Angeles (the “City”), acting by and through the Office of the Mayor, and the Los Angeles Sports & Entertainment Commission (“LASEC”), a California non-profit corporation. City and LASEC are sometimes referred to collectively as “Parties” or individually as a “Party.”

RECITALS

The Parties make this Agreement with reference to the following facts and circumstances:

WHEREAS, the National Football League's 56th Super Bowl (“Super Bowl LVI”) will take place within the City of Inglewood on February 13th, 2022; and

WHEREAS, LASEC, on behalf of the Los Angeles Super Bowl Host Committee, a California non-profit corporation (“LASBHC”), is assisting NFL Properties, Inc. (the “NFL”) with the staging of various Super Bowl LVI related events (the “Super Bowl LVI Events”) within the City of Los Angeles during the two weeks preceding Super Bowl LVI at the Los Angeles Convention Center, JW Marriott LA Live, InterContinental Hotel, Hudson Lofts, and the Academy Museum of Motion Pictures; and

WHEREAS, in October 2009, the City enacted an ordinance that created a “One-Stop Shop” special events permitting process administered by the Los Angeles Department of Public Works Bureau of Street Services; and

WHEREAS, the City and LASEC are entering into this Agreement in order to facilitate the issuance of a special event permit covering the various Super Bowl LVI Events identified herein; and

WHEREAS, under the City’s special event permitting process, a special event permit is required for the provision of City services that are necessary to effectuate the event; and

WHEREAS, LASEC has requested that City provide certain supplemental City services in support of LASEC’s efforts to assist the NFL in staging the Super Bowl LVI Events; and

WHEREAS, LASEC desires to facilitate the full and complete reimbursement of City for all supplemental services provided by City; and

WHEREAS, with respect to the provision of supplemental police services, this Agreement is authorized pursuant to California Government Code section 53069.8; and

WHEREAS, California Government Code section 53069.8 specifically authorizes the City Council to contract on behalf of the Chief of Police to provide supplemental law enforcement services to private entity-sponsored special events; and

WHEREAS, the City is agreeable to rendering such supplemental City services, as available, on the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

1. RECITALS

1.1. The recitals set forth above are fully incorporated into this Agreement.

2. REQUESTED CITY SERVICES

2.1. This Agreement is for the provision of supplemental City services requested by LASEC to support public safety and traffic management at the Super Bowl LVI Events. Specifically, City shall provide, and LASEC shall reimburse City for, the cost of providing, the following (collectively, the “Requested City Services”):

2.1.1. Law enforcement services, as further articulated in Exhibit A (the “LAPD Services”), incorporated herein by reference;

2.1.2. Fire inspection and liaison services, as further articulated in Exhibit B (the “LAFD Services”), incorporated herein by reference; and

2.1.3. Traffic management services, as further articulated in Exhibit C (the “LADOT Services”), incorporated herein by reference.

3. CONDITIONS OF LAPD SERVICES

3.1. The City agrees, as available, through the LAPD, to provide certain supplemental law enforcement services at the Super Bowl LVI Events. The service levels required under this Agreement have been developed by the LAPD, in consultation with LASEC. The pre-determined service levels to be provided by the LAPD under this Agreement are set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

3.2. The services to be provided by LAPD encompass only law enforcement duties and not services authorized to be provided by private patrol operators, as defined in California Business and Professions Code section 7582.1, nor the enforcement of any rules, regulations, and/or policies of LASEC or any LASEC affiliates or contractors, including the NFL and LASBHC, that are participating with, or at the direction of, LASEC in the delivery of the Super Bowl LVI Events.

3.3. Notwithstanding any term herein to the contrary, each sworn member of the LAPD assigned work pursuant to this Agreement is subject to recall by the Chief of Police or the Chief’s designee at any time for emergencies, special assignment, or overtime duty.

- 3.4. The supplemental law enforcement services provided under this Agreement shall not reduce the normal and regular ongoing services that the City would otherwise provide if the City did not enter into this Agreement.
- 3.5. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Agreement, the LAPD may forthwith cancel the provision of supplemental law enforcement services under this Agreement if the LAPD concludes that it has insufficient available personnel to provide the services required by this Agreement and to perform the LAPD's other duties as required by law.
- 3.6. The supplemental law enforcement services provided under this Agreement shall only encompass duties and functions that LAPD may permissibly render under the Charter of the City, the statutes and laws of the State of California, and the policies and procedures of the LAPD.
- 3.7. LASEC understands and agrees that the provision of supplemental law enforcement services provided under this Agreement does not guarantee the absence of the occurrence of crime at the times and places of provision of those services. The LAPD shall have no obligation to patrol or provide law enforcement at any specific location at any particular times except under a schedule agreed to by LAPD at LAPD's sole discretion and subject to the limitations of this Agreement.
- 3.8. Notwithstanding the foregoing, no increases in deployment or assignments will be deemed requested by LASEC, absent such request having received the direct written or email approval of LASEC (which may be given on behalf of LASEC by Douglas Arnot).

4. FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT

- 4.1. Except as otherwise specified herein, City is not obligated to furnish any facilities or equipment pursuant to this Agreement. City, at City's sole discretion, may furnish other equipment in furtherance of the provision of services under this Agreement, provided that, except as expressly provided in Section 10.3, LASEC shall not be obligated to reimburse the City for such additional equipment absent mutual agreement between the City and LASEC.

5. ADMINISTRATION OF PERSONNEL

- 5.1. The rendition of the services, the rank of the personnel provided, the selection and discipline of the Chief's personnel provided, the manner of performance of the policing function, the supervision, equipment, communications, supplies, and other matters incident to the performance of such services, and the control of such personnel will remain with the City department primarily responsible for providing the contemplated service.
- 5.2. All persons employed in the performance of the supplemental law enforcement services provided under this Agreement shall be City employees.
- 5.3. All LASEC employees who work in conjunction with the City pursuant to this Agreement shall remain employees of LASEC and shall not have any claim or right to employment, civil service protection, salary, or benefits or claims of any kind from the City based on this Agreement. No LASEC employees or volunteers shall become

employees or volunteers of the City. No City employees or volunteers shall become employees or volunteers of LASEC.

- 5.4. Both Parties hereto in the performance of this Agreement shall act as independent contractors and not as agents, employees, partners, joint venturers, or associates of one another.

6. INDEMNIFICATION

- 6.1. Except for the active negligence or willful misconduct of City, or any of its boards, officers, agents, employees, assigns and successors in interest, LASEC shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless City and any of its boards, officers, agents, employees, assigns, and successors in interest from and against all lawsuits and causes of action, claims, losses, demands, deficiencies, judgments, settlements, costs, and expenses of any kind, including, but not limited to, attorney's fees (both in house and outside counsel), damages or liability of any nature whatsoever, relating to or, arising in any manner by reason of the negligent acts, errors, omissions or willful misconduct by LASEC, any of its subcontractors, or their boards, officers, agents, employees, assigns, and successors in interest (excluding the NFL and its affiliated entities). The rights and remedies of City provided in this section shall not be exclusive and are in addition to any other rights and remedies provided by law or under this Agreement.
- 6.2. If liability is imposed by reason of a dangerous physical condition of the property of LASEC or its affiliates, LASEC shall assume liability and defend and hold harmless the City, its officers, employees, and agents from any action, loss, costs, or expenses caused by any physical condition of LASEC's property and any negligent or wrongful act or omission of LASEC's officers, agents, and employees, in any way connected with such physical condition of LASEC's property.

7. PERMITS AND INSURANCE

- 7.1. As a condition precedent to entering into this Agreement, LASEC shall have pulled Special Event permits pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code section 41.20 and signed indemnification forms pursuant to those permits.
- 7.2. In consideration of the granting of the special event/street closure permit, and without limiting the LASEC's indemnification of the City, the LASEC shall provide and maintain at its own expense during the term of this Agreement the insurance to cover the LASEC's Events and Activities hereunder subject to the following conditions:
- 7.2.1. The City, its Boards, Officers, Agents and Employees shall be included as additional insureds in all liability insurance policies.
- 7.2.2. Such insurance shall be primary with respect to any insurance maintained by the City and shall not call on the City's insurance for contributions.
- 7.2.3. It shall be obtained from brokers or carriers authorized to transact insurance business in California.
- 7.2.4. Evidence of insurance shall be submitted and shall be subject to approval by the City and shall meet the "Required Insurance and Minimum Limits" (Exhibit C").

- 7.3. Failure on the part of the LASEC to procure or maintain required insurance shall constitute a material breach of contract under which the City may immediately terminate this Agreement.

8. TERM OF AGREEMENT

- 8.1. The term of this Agreement shall commence January 30, 2022 and shall terminate June 30, 2022, unless sooner terminated or extended in whole or in part as provided for herein.
- 8.2. For the avoidance of doubt, LASEC acknowledges and agrees that LASEC is obliged to, and shall, compensate City for all Requested City Services in the manner provided for in Sections 10 and 11 below, regardless of whether those Requested City Services were provided prior to the execution of this Agreement.

9. TERMINATION

- 9.1. City shall have the right to terminate this Agreement at any time, effective upon seven (7) days written notice to LASEC, in the City's sole discretion of with or without cause, by giving notice to LASEC. Upon the effectiveness of termination, City shall immediately cease rendering services pursuant to this Agreement and LASEC shall pay to City the value of services rendered pursuant to this Agreement. City shall have no liability to LASEC for any failure to perform the services required by this Agreement regardless of when such termination occurs, and City shall not be liable for lost profits or punitive, special, indirect, or consequential damages, even if City has been advised of the possibility of such damages.

10. COMPENSATION

- 10.1. Except as otherwise provided in Section 10.2 below, LASEC shall pay the City, as compensation for City services furnished under this Agreement, an amount estimated to be \$4,216,404.00 (the "Estimated City Services Costs"), which consists of the following estimated costs from the following City departments:
- 10.1.1. LAPD Services: \$3,860,000.00
- 10.1.2. LAFD Services: \$201,904.00
- 10.1.3. LADOT Services: \$154,500.00
- 10.2. LASEC and the City each recognizes and acknowledges that the above-estimated special event permit fees constitute an estimate for the costs of the Requested City Services and may be revised at the conclusion of the events and activities of LASEC as set forth in Los Angeles Municipal Code section 41.20(c). If actual fees and charges for the Requested City Services are less than the estimated fee paid, LASEC shall be refunded the difference. If actual fees and charges for the Super Bowl LVI Events are greater than the Estimated City Services Cost, LASEC shall be liable for the additional costs and shall make payment to City as provided below.
- 10.3. For the avoidance of doubt, LASEC acknowledges and agrees that City may incur additional costs that are directly attributable to providing public safety services at the Super Bowl LVI Events. Pursuant to California Government Code section 53069.8,

LASEC shall pay City for all costs that are attributable to the provision of supplemental law enforcement services to the Super Bowl LVI Events.

- 10.4. LASEC acknowledges and agrees that neither this Agreement nor LASEC's performance of the terms of this Agreement operate to reduce or impair the obligations of any other party to make payment to City for services rendered or properties leased in relation to the Super Bowl LVI Events. Further, LASEC acknowledges and agrees that no payments made by other entities to City for related services will reduce LASEC's obligation to make payment to City as provided in this Agreement.

11. PAYMENT

- 11.1. By February 15, 2022 LASEC shall pay to City an amount not less than \$843,280.80 (the "Estimate Percentage Payment"), consisting of 20% of the Estimated City Services Costs provided in Section 10.1.
- 11.2. Upon completion of Requested City Services for the Super Bowl LVI Events, the City shall provide to LASEC a summarized invoice which covers all services performed under this Agreement, and LASEC shall pay City for all undisputed amounts, less the Estimate Percentage Payment of \$843,280.80, within sixty (60) calendar days after date of said invoice. Payment for said services shall be made as directed on the invoice or as otherwise agreed to by the parties.
- 11.3. If such payment is not delivered to the City within sixty (60) calendar days after the date of the invoice, the City is entitled to recover interest thereon. For all disputed amounts, LASEC shall provide City with written notice of the dispute including the invoice date, amount, and reasons for dispute within (10) calendar days after receipt of the invoice. The Parties shall memorialize the resolution of the dispute in writing. For any disputed amounts, interest shall accrue if payment is not received within sixty (60) calendar days after the dispute resolution is memorialized.
- 11.4. Said interest shall be at a rate of ten percent (10%) per annum or any portion thereof, calculated from the date payment was due pursuant to Sections 11.2 and 11.3, above.

12. AMENDMENTS

- 12.1. No changes, modifications, or amendments to this Agreement may occur except by written Amendment duly executed on behalf of the City by the person designated by the City Council, or by the board, officer or employee authorized to enter into this Agreement, and LASEC.

13. NO GRANT OF AGENCY

- 13.1. For the avoidance of doubt, neither Party shall have authority, express or implied, to act on behalf of the other Party in any capacity whatsoever as an agent. Neither Party shall have any authority, express or implied, pursuant to this Agreement to bind the other Party to any obligation whatsoever.

14. AUTHORIZATION WARRANTY

- 14.1. LASEC represents and warrants that the person executing this Agreement for LASEC is an authorized agent who has actual authority to bind LASEC to each and every term, condition, and obligation of this Agreement and that all requirements of LASEC have been fulfilled to provide such actual authority.

15. COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS AND REGULATIONS

- 15.1. LASEC represents and warrants to City that, to the best of LASEC's knowledge, LASEC or the NFL, as applicable, has obtained all licenses, permits, City Business Tax Registration Certificate, and approvals of whatsoever nature which it is legally required to possess to conduct the Super Bowl LVI Events. LASEC represents and warrants to City that LASEC or the NFL, as applicable, shall, at its sole cost and expense, keep in effect or obtain at all times during the term of this Agreement any required licenses, certificates, permits and approvals. LASEC shall comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws, ordinances, rules and regulations pertaining to its obligations under this Agreement, including but not limited to, laws regarding health and safety, labor and employment, wage and hours and licensing.

16. GOVERNING LAW AND VENUE

- 16.1. This Agreement shall be enforced and interpreted under the laws of the State of California without regard to conflict of law principles. LASEC shall comply with new, amended, or revised laws, regulations, or procedures that apply to the performance of this Agreement.
- 16.2. In any action arising out of this Agreement, LASEC consents to personal jurisdiction, and agrees to bring all such actions, exclusively in state or federal courts located in Los Angeles County, California.

17. NOTICES

- 17.1. Any notice required to be given pursuant to this Agreement shall be in writing and mailed by certified or registered mail, return receipt requested, or delivered by a national overnight express service in each case to the address and to the attention of the party set forth below.

18. SEVERABILITY

18.1. If any term, clause, or provision hereof is held invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the validity or operation of any other term, clause, or provision and such invalid term, clause, or provision shall be deemed to have been severed from the Agreement.

19. WAIVER

19.1. A waiver of a default of any part, term or provision of this Agreement shall not be construed as a waiver of any succeeding default or as a waiver of the part, term or provision itself. A Party's performance after the other Party's default shall not be construed as a waiver of that default.

20. SURVIVAL

20.1. Sections 6, 16, and 21 will survive termination of this Agreement.

21. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

21.1. City will not be liable hereunder for special, indirect, consequential, or incidental damages including, but not limited to, lost profits, lost or damaged data, failure to achieve cost savings, or the failure or increased expense of operations, regardless of whether any such losses or damages are characterized as arising from strict liability or otherwise, even if City is advised of the possibility of such losses or damages, or if such losses or damages are foreseeable.

22. NO ASSIGNMENT

22.1. LASEC shall not assign, subcontract, delegate, or otherwise transfer this Agreement, or its rights and obligations herein, without obtaining the prior written consent of City, and any attempted such assignment, subcontract delegation, or transfer in violation of the foregoing will be null and void.

23. INTEGRATED AGREEMENT

23.1. This Agreement sets forth all of the rights and duties of the Parties with respect to the subject matter of this Agreement, and replaces any and all previous Agreements or understandings, whether written or oral, relating thereto. This Agreement may be amended only as provided for in the provisions of Section 12 hereof.
