Summary: The Reseda Neighborhood Council SUPPORTS CF 22-0158 that would make it easier for local neighborhoods to use existing structures i.e. existing faith community buildings and other non-profit entities to create shelters and increase the desperately needed bed supply for those experiencing homelessness. In addition, our current restrictive zoning acts as a barrier against getting unhoused folks into the shelter they need. These zoning regulations should be adjusted to allow for more people to come inside. The Reseda Neighborhood Council supports a report back on this issue so that the topic may be studied in further detail. The vote took place in a meeting in accordance with the Brown Act on February 24, 2022. The vote was 11 in favor, 3 absent.
