Summary:

On April 13, 2022, at a Brown Act Compliant Meeting, NoHo Neighborhood Council voted 12-0-1 to SUPPORT CF 22-0158, a motion that would make it easier for local neighborhoods to use existing structures (e.g. existing faith community buildings) and other non-profit entities to create shelters and increase the desperately needed bed supply for those experiencing homelessness. In addition, our current restrictive zoning acts as a barrier against getting unhoused folks into the shelter they need. These zoning regulations should be adjusted to allow for more people to come inside. NoHo Neighborhood Council supports a report back on this issue so that the topic may be studied in further detail.
