

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a proposed Agreement between the Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD) and Rescue Advancement, Inc. to provide Aeromedical Clinical Care Coordinator services to the LAFD’s Air Operations Section.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the Chief, LAFD, or designee, to execute an Agreement contained in the City Administrative Officer (CAO) report dated June 7, 2022, attached to Council file No. 22-0273, with Rescue Advancement Incorporated for Aeromedical Clinical Care Coordinator services for a three-year term, plus the authority to execute amendments for up to two one-year extensions, with a total maximum compensation not to exceed \$446,304, contingent on the availability of funds and the contractor having provided satisfactory services in the Agreement.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The CAO reports that there is no impact to the General Fund. The proposed contract with Rescue Advancement Incorporated will be fully funded by the County of Los Angeles Measure B – Preservation of Trauma Centers and Emergency Medical Services Fund.

Financial Policies Statement: The CAO reports that the recommendation in the report complies with the City’s Financial Policies in that the City’s financial obligation is limited to funds budgeted for this purpose.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted

SUMMARY

At the meeting held on June 30, 2022, your Public Safety Committee considered a CAO report relative to a proposed Agreement between the LAFD and Rescue Advancement, Inc. to provide Aeromedical Clinical Care Coordinator services to the LAFD’s Air Operations Section.
