

PERSONNEL, AUDITS, AND ANIMAL WELFARE COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the exemption of one Senior Project Coordinator (Class Code 1538) position for the Civil, Human Rights and Equity Department (CHRED) from the Civil Service pursuant to Charter Section 1001(b).

Recommendation for Council action:

APPROVE the exemption of one Senior Project Coordinator (Class Code 1538) position for the CHRED from the Civil Service pursuant to Charter Section 1001(b).

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Mayor. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Summary:

On April 6, 2022, your Committee considered a March 30, 2022 communication from the Mayor relative to the exemption of one Senior Project Coordinator (Class Code 1538) position for the Civil, Human Rights and Equity Department from the Civil Service pursuant to Charter Section 1001(b). According to the Mayor, the CHRED has requested that the Mayor approve the exemption of one new position of Senior Project Coordinator, Class Code 1538, in accordance with Charter Section 1001(b), from Civil Service as management, professional, scientific, or expert services exemptions. Charter Section 1001(b) allows up to 150 persons to be exempt, of which 148 are approved. Approval of this request will increase the count. As of March 30, 2022, this request will be in the 149<sup>th</sup> position of the 150 exemptions. There are an additional 50 exempt positions added by the City Council pursuant to Charter Section 1001(b)(4), of which six are filled. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the exemption as detailed above. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
