

PUBLIC SAFETY and TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEES REPORT relative to improving safety in City transit systems and station stops as it relates to serious and violent crimes; and past and upcoming efforts to curtail the issue of violent crimes on trains, buses and transportation stops, including an analysis of armed and unarmed response models.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Buscaino – O’Farrell):

1. DIRECT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation and the Los Angeles Police Department to report on how to improve safety in all City transit systems and station stops as it relates to serious and violent crimes.
2. REQUEST the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority to report with past and upcoming efforts to curtail the issue of violent crimes on trains, buses and transportation stops; including an analysis of armed and unarmed response models.
