These investments will continue to produce important results for the City and its residents.


There are several areas that will require close monitoring over the course of the next Fiscal Year. Most notably, the chronically underfunded Litigation Expense account will no doubt require supplemental funding at both the mid-year and year end, as in the past. In addition, several significant litigation matters, being handled by outside counsel, will likely require enhanced funding. This includes the HUD False Claims Act case as well as the more than three dozen police protest cases.
