ORDINANCE NO.	

An ordinance repealing Ordinance No. 182,576, adopted on May 28, 2013, to establish the Bunker Hill Specific Plan for the area bounded generally by the I-110 Freeway on the west, Fifth Street on the south, Hill Street on the east, and First Street on the north.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 182,576, which established the Bunker Hill Specific Plan, is repealed.

Sec. 2. This ordinance shall be operative on January 27, 2025.

Sec. 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.
