

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to executing an agreement with Los Angeles Cleantech Incubator (LACI) for the South LA EcoLab.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the Department of Transportation (DOT) to enter into an agreement with LACI for a term from July 24, 2023 to March 31, 2029, with an amount not to exceed \$3,267,460, for implementation of the e-bike lending library project funded by the Transformative Climate Communities (TCC) grant South LA EcoLab.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The DOT reports that the TCC grant requires leveraged funding in an amount at least 50 percent of the total grant funding. The DOT identified \$67,775 of in-kind staff time, \$250,000 in Measure R funds, \$600,000 in Bikeshare Capital Funds, and \$500,000 in California Air Resources Board Sustainable Transportation Equity Project match funds to support project implementation. There is no additional anticipated impact on the General Fund since the South LA EcoLab projects are expected to be completed within the approved budget. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.
