

PUBLIC WORKS AND BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEES' REPORT relative to the establishment of a Sixth Street Viaduct Maintenance Trust Fund for the receipt, retention, and disbursement of gifts, contributions, and donations for maintenance of the Sixth Street Viaduct Bridge.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Jurado – Price):

INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer (CAO), in consultation with Council District 14 and City Attorney, to report on the establishment of a Sixth Street Viaduct Maintenance Trust Fund for the purpose of receipt, retention and disbursement of gifts, contributions, and donations for maintenance of the Sixth Street Viaduct, including trash and bulky item pickup, graffiti abatement, and other services.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

SUMMARY

At the meeting held on June 24, 2026, your Public Works Committee considered a Motion (Jurado – Price) relative to the establishment of a Sixth Street Viaduct Maintenance Trust Fund for the receipt, retention, and disbursement of gifts, contributions, and donations for maintenance of the Sixth Street Viaduct Bridge. After an opportunity for public comment was held, the Committee moved to approve the recommendation contained in the Motion, as detailed above.
