

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a proposed Agreement between Axon Enterprise, Inc. and the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) for the installation and replacement of the Digital In-Car Video System in police vehicles.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the Chief of Police, LAPD, or designee, to execute the proposed Agreement contained in the City Administrative Officer (CAO) report dated June 10, 2022, attached to Council file No. 22-0721, with Axon Enterprise, Inc., for the replacement of the Digital In-Car Video System. The term of the agreement is five years from the date of execution, with one option to extend for an additional five years, with a maximum allowable compensation amount not to exceed \$6,875,890, subject to the review and approval of the City Attorney as to form.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The CAO reports that approval of the recommendation stated in this report will authorize the LAPD to enter into an agreement with Axon Enterprise, Inc., for the replacement of a Digital In-Car Video System. The term of the agreement is five years from the date of execution, with one option to extend for an additional five years, with a maximum allowable compensation not to exceed \$6,875,890. Funding is provided within the LAPD's Contractual Services Account No. 003040 previously encumbered for these purposes. There is no additional impact to the General Fund.

Financial Policies Statement: The CAO reports that the recommendation stated in this report is in compliance with the City's Financial Policies in that one-time revenues will be used to support one-time expenditures.
