In the midst of a housing crisis, Los Angeles is still not adequately enforcing its short term rental law. The Responsible Hotel Ordinance will give the City new tools to ensure that unlawful short term rentals can be held accountable. using the same license system used for over 70 other types of permit. Unregulated short term rentals have been the scene of crime, including 3 killed at a short term rental in Beverly Crest last year. Just this week, yet another scandal emerged when a clean-up crew for a short term rental in Alhambra found boxes containing 235 pounds of methamphetamine. Please do not delay implementation of the law.
