Dear LA City Council President Martinez,

Since February 2022, Council District 10 has been continuously plagued by injunctions to remove Herb Wesson, who the City Council appointed as interim 10th District Councilmember. This latest injunction has taken away all voting powers from Herb Wesson, effectively removing proper representation for CD10. In an effort to show support for Council District 10, the City Council appointed Chief of Staff Heather Hutt as Caretaker. Unfortunately, Ms. Hutt has no voting power and is not allowed to present motions which for the community is very frustrating.

This latest lawsuit filed by the Southern Christian Leadership Conference of Southern California (SCLC) to challenge Council Member Wesson's appointment yet again leaves the constituents of CD10 at a disadvantage. Ms. Hutt is committed to serving the community. She has years of experience serving at both the state and federal levels of government, establishing strong relationships with elected officials on all levels. Ms. Hutt understands our needs, knows our history, lives in the community, and has the experience and integrity needed to represent CD10 well.

Council District 10 has over 250,000 constituents without a vote at the City Council, which significantly impacts services and resources. The constituents of CD10 cannot be fairly and adequately represented unless they have a voting representative on the City Council.

I am requesting that the Los Angeles City Council appoint Miss Heather Hutt to the vacant Councilmember seat in CD10, so she will have full voting rights and CD10 will have the proper representation it so desperately needs.
