PUBLIC SAFETY

I MOVE that the City Council instruct the appropriate City departments to report back within 30 days on the implementation status of Council File 22-1019, including:

1. An updated list, by geographic LAPD Bureau, of the top 50 locations, based on recent data from 2024 through 2026, including calls for service and other identified public safety needs;
2. An assessment of the City's current capacity and ability to treat the updated locations, including any staffing, equipment, contracting, interjurisdictional coordination, or mutual aid needs for locations spanning multiple jurisdictions, and other operational constraints;
3. An update on the locations previously identified pursuant to Council File 22-1019, including which locations remain current and appropriate for treatment, which locations have been treated, and the total costs incurred to date;
4. Identification of available City, State, Federal, and other funding sources that could be used to fund treatment of all identified locations, including potential grant opportunities; and
5. Departmental recommendations regarding prioritization and implementation, including a funding strategy and estimated resources necessary to complete treatment of all identified locations.
