Dear Honorable Members:

On February 6, 2024, the Los Angeles City Council (Council) approved Council File 22-1019 that was transmitted by the Public Safety Committee. The Public Safety Committee Report was relative to street racing and intersection takeovers, and strategies to combat this ongoing problem. The Council File directed and instructed the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) and the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) to proceed with various actions to combat street racing and intersection takeovers.

The LAPD was directed to report to the Council with 50 locations throughout the City that have continuous issues with street takeovers and racing. The LAPD is divided into four geographic bureaus that are serviced by four traffic divisions. Each traffic division was directed to provide a list of problematic street intersections. This list is attached for your awareness and has been provided to the LADOT.
