

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a Special Election was ordered to be held in the City of Los Angeles pursuant to Ordinance No. 187388 to place a measure before the voters and the election was consolidated with the City of Los Angeles Primary Nominating Election; and

WHEREAS, the following measure was submitted to a vote of the qualified voters of the City of Los Angeles:

**COMPETITIVE BID PREFERENCE FOR LOCAL CONTRACT BIDDERS.  
CHARTER AMENDMENT BB.**

Shall the City Charter be amended to allow the City, on a competitive bid contract, to award a bid preference to a bidder located in the City of Los Angeles?

WHEREAS, the County of Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk did canvass the returns of the Primary Nominating Election held in the City of Los Angeles on June 7, 2022, and certified them to the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Los Angeles City Council that the canvass of votes is true and correct.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Los Angeles City Council hereby finds, determines, and declares that the total number of votes cast for and against City of Los Angeles Charter Amendment BB at the Primary Nominating Election by the qualified voters was 552,621 as set forth in the certification of the Los Angeles City Clerk, and that the measure, as proposed by Resolution of the Los Angeles City Council, is hereby declared to have been approved by a majority of the voters voting thereon.

I HEREBY CERTIFY that the foregoing Resolution was adopted by the Los Angeles City Council at its meeting of July 27, 2022.
