## COMPETITIVE BID PREFERENCE FOR LOCAL CONTRACT BIDDERS, CHARTER AMENDMENT BB

## FINANCIAL IMPACT STATEMENT BY MATTHEW W. SZABO, CITY ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER

This measure will allow the City of Los Angeles to award a competitive bid preference to City located businesses bidding on City contracts. Currently, the City may award a competitive bid preference to businesses that occupy work space within the County of Los Angeles. Through this measure, the City may narrow the competitive bid preference eligibility to businesses located within the City of Los Angeles. Narrowing the eligibility may result in more City located businesses awarded competitively bid contracts. However, the final selection of a business for a contract award will continue to depend on a comprehensive evaluation of each bid with respect to cost, experience, and other contract requirements. Contract awards are also subject to budgeted resources. Since businesses located within the City of Los Angeles are already eligible for a competitive bid preference, no substantial net change in the City's finances will result if the measure is adopted.
