Re: Defamatory, racist remarks and action

Not our values...

As Union members and constituents within the City of Los Angeles, we are appalled and disappointed by the remarks and actions by three (3) city council members and find it inexcusable to defend such actions. A main value for our Union is the respect, integrity, and genuine leadership anyone asking for support and being elected is expected to give our membership, our families and society in general. Article 39 of our UAW Constitution calls for elected leaders to “faithfully perform your duties so that you may gain not only the esteem of your brothers and sisters, but what is of even more importance, the approval of your conscience”. It is obvious that conscience was absent at the time the remarks were made.

In a political atmosphere seeded by cultural and partisan bias where divisions have grown wider with racial and ethnic rhetoric brought by people only interested in dividing all common goals of equity, integrity, and respect for decent and democratic values, we find it inexcusable that these leaders allowed those very divisive statements further tear the fibers we are trying to strengthen and improve.

Sadly, the damage is done and the only way to start sincere healing and avoid additional divisions is by demanding that these leaders have the dignity and honesty required to recognize the damage, as L.A. Federation President Ron Herrera has, and resign from their respective positions having acknowledged the error in judgement and hurtful actions they took part in.

We further rescind any endorsement that our membership might have recommended or supported to assure our UAW membership that values protecting racial justice, LGBTQ rights, indigenous peoples' rights, and the rights of people living with stressful rent burdens within the jurisdiction of the council continue to be the main priority. As we should know, “integrity is what you do when no one is watching, it is doing the right thing all the time, even when it may work to your disadvantage”.

Our members deserve better, so does the City of Los Angeles.
