**RE: THE LINCOLN HEIGHTS NEIGHBORHOOD COUNCIL DEMANDS THE
CENSURE AND IMMEDIATE RESIGNATION OF LOS ANGELES CITY COUNCIL
MEMBERS KEVIN DE LEON, AND GIL CEDILLO .**

City Officers are lawmakers and therefore in a trusted position of power and authority. The City's policy of selected discipline, or at times lack thereof, normalizes unethical behavior and perpetuates systemic racism, abuse of power and harm to the most vulnerable. For public confidence to be restored, the city must conduct their proceedings in an open and participatory process so the public becomes a part of the solution and has the agency to keep their tool in good working order and monitor the Delivery of Services. Internally, the City must enforce laws which prohibit harassment, intimidation, or violence motivated by prejudice, bigotry or racism & must remove elected officials who use their power to cause harm.

The LHNC requests the City to take immediate action to prevent Council members Gil Cedillo and Kevin de Leon from causing further damage. The LHNC further requests the City to authorize an investigation into any/all misconduct that Cedillo, de Leon and Martinez have engaged in during their (multiple) terms. The LHNC further requests the City to authorize an assessment of all Officers of the City, and take complete inventory of the City Council's past actions, including redistricting, land use, and the phasing out of tenant protections. There is evidence that indicates their past official actions may have been tainted by greed, bias, racism and hate which has harmed the most vulnerable in Lincoln Heights.
