Recommendations for Council action? SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR: 1. DIRECT the City Administrative Officer (CAO), with the support of all relevant City departments, the Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority (LAHSA), and the St. Joseph Center, to coordinate a comprehensive service-led response at West Jefferson Boulevard, between Culver Boulevard and Lincoln Boulevard, modeled after successful Encampment to Home operations in Council District 11, and incorporating best practices from vehicular homelessness interventions by West Valley Homes Yes (WHVY) and L.A. Family Housing in Council District 7. The operation shall commence only upon the determination by Council District 11 that housing and vehicular interventions are in fact available for potential clients, and will provide for a minimum of three weeks of active engagement with people experiencing homelessness at the location. 2. AUTHORIZE the transfer of \$2,283,313 from the Additional Homeless Services General City Purposes Fund No. 100/56, Account No. 000931, Additional Homeless Services to the Los Angeles Housing Department Fund No. 10A/43, in a new account entitled "Westchester/Playa Vehicular Homelessness Intervention Program" for the above described vehicular homelessness interventions within the Westchester/Playa vicinity. 3. INSTRUCT the General Manager, Los Angeles Housing Department, or designee, to amend the LAHSA General Fund Contract (No. C140706) to reflect the funding allocation as mentioned above. 4. REQUEST the LAHSA execute a new or amend an existing sole source subcontract with the St. Joseph Center for an amount of \$2,283,313 to implement the Council District 11 Westchester/Playa Vehicular Homelessness Intervention Program. 5. AUTHORIZE the CAO to prepare Controller instructions or make necessary technical adjustments, including to the names of the Special Fund accounts recommended for this report, to

implement the intent of these transactions? and, AUTHORIZE the Controller to implement these instructions. 4. REQUEST the LAHSA execute a new or amend an existing sole source subcontract with the St. Joseph Center for an amount of \$2,283,313 to implement the Council District 11 Westchester/Playa Vehicular Homelessness Intervention Program. 5. AUTHORIZE the CAO to prepare Controller instructions or make necessary technical adjustments, including to the names of the Special Fund accounts recommended for this report, to implement the intent of these transactions? and, AUTHORIZE the Controller to implement these instructions.
