

ADMINISTRATIVE EXEMPTION and TRADE, TRAVEL, AND TOURISM COMMITTEE REPORT relative to Port of Los Angeles (POLA) Resolution No. 26-10708 for the First Amendment to the Second Memorandum of Understanding between the Housing Authority of the City of Los Angeles and the Harbor Department for the Harbor Boulevard Parkway Improvement Project.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. CONCUR that the determination by the Board of Harbor Commissioners (BOHC) that the proposed action is administratively exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Article II, Section 2(f) of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines.
2. APPROVE POLA Resolution No. 26-10708 for the First Amendment to the Second Memorandum of Understanding between the Housing Authority of the City of Los Angeles and the Harbor Department for the Harbor Boulevard Parkway Improvement Project.
3. AUTHORIZE the POLA Executive Director, or designee, to execute said First Amendment to the Second Memorandum of Understanding between the Housing Authority of the City of Los Angeles and the Harbor Department.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The BOHC reports that there is no impact to the General Fund. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.
