Dear City Councilmembers,

We declare that on March 7, 2023, a Brown Act noticed public meeting was held by the Eagle Rock Neighborhood Council (ERNC) at which a quorum was present. The following motion passed unanimously:

The ERNC requests of the City of Los Angeles include in its 2023-2024 State Legislative Program, support for an amendment to the Ralph M. Brown Act permitting the City of Los Angeles Neighborhood Council system to indefinitely continue to hold its meetings virtually via a telecommunications platform.
