

RULES, ELECTIONS AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position regarding Assembly Bill (AB) AB 249 (Holden), a requirement to test for lead in potable water system outlets at all public K-12 and daycare facilities and require immediate notice and remediation of sources of lead exposure under penalty of citation by the State Board of Education.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Hutt - Yaroslavsky – Blumenfield), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

RESOLVE to include in the City's 2023-24 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for AB 249 (Holden), a requirement to test for lead in potable water system outlets at all public K-12 and daycare facilities and require immediate notice and remediation of sources of lead exposure under penalty of citation by the State Board of Education.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the Chief Legislative Analyst nor the City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

SUMMARY

At its meeting held on September 15, 2023, the Rules, Elections and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered Resolution (Hutt - Yaroslavsky - Blumenfield) to include in the City's 2023-24 State Legislative Program a position on AB 249 (Holden), a requirement to test for lead in potable water system outlets at all public K-12 and daycare facilities and require immediate notice and remediation of sources of lead exposure under penalty of citation by the State Board of Education..

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council adopt the Resolution. This matter is now forwarded to Council for its consideration.
