Comments for Public Posting: Dear members of the Los Angeles City Council, Please vote in support of implementing parking restrictions for oversized vehicles. I read some of the other public comments and I agree that a solution to homelessness and the cost-of-living crisis is urgently needed. There are no easy answers, these are very complex issues. But allowing RV's to park wherever they want, especially in residential streets, is not the solution. I speak from firsthand experience. We have had RV's next to our house for 3+ years in our small residential street. In addition to their large RV's, the RV residents also own cars and/or motorbikes, all of which are parked along our street and monopolize the parking spaces available. These vehicles rarely move, so our parking availability is pretty much permanently impacted. Our livability and the functionality of our neighborhood are negatively impacted by the restricted parking, trash, noise, and most of all safety concerns. Safety both in the sense that people are scared to walk along our street or let their kids play there, but also road safety. Large RV's severely obstruct visibility for both drivers and pedestrians. If the RV's are parked on both sides of our street one car can narrowly pass. A car might not see a pedestrian coming out from behind an RV (and vice versa the pedestrian would not see the car). Comments for Public Posting: Dear Members of the Los Angeles City Council, I am writing to express my strong support for the implementation of parking restrictions for oversized vehicles as per file 23-0008-S6. Such vehicles can obstruct visibility at intersections and make it difficult for drivers to navigate safely. This poses a significant risk to both motorists and pedestrians, potentially leading to accidents and injuries. In addition, the implementation of parking restrictions for oversized vehicles would be consistent with SEC. 80.71.3. PARKING IN FRONT YARDS, which prohibits parking in front yards and helps maintain the aesthetics and order of residential areas. By enforcing similar regulations for oversized vehicles, we can ensure a harmonious coexistence between residents and vehicle owners. Moreover, I would like to draw your attention to a few specific incidents that have occurred in front of our house due to unregulated parking of oversized vehicles. One case involved an individual who parked an RV housing an attack dog, likely a Pit Bull, in front of our house, causing distress and concerns for the safety of our neighborhood. Additionally, there was an instance where an individual used an RV parked in front of our house as a location for drug consumption, and the occupants littered used syringes in the

vicinity, posing a significant health and safety risk. In light of these issues, I respectfully request that the Los Angeles City Council consider implementing parking restrictions for oversized vehicles. By doing so, you would greatly contribute to alleviating the problems associated with the excessive presence of these vehicles in our neighborhoods. Such regulations would not only enhance the quality of life for residents but also prioritize the safety and security of our community. Thank you for your attention to this matter.
