

MOTION

I MOVE that Motion (Padilla – Blumenfield), relative to Measure ULA Citizens Oversight Committee reforms, Item No. 7 on today’s agenda, **BE AMENDED** to remove the second moving clause in its entirety and replace it with the following language.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Council request the City Attorney, in consultation with the Chief Legislative Analyst, Los Angeles Housing Department, and any other relevant departments, to prepare and present within 15 days the documents necessary to place before voters in the next feasible election a measure that would amend Measure ULA to revise eligibility requirements of ULA Citizens Oversight Committee members by replacing the rigid, seat-by-seat eligibility requirements for the House LA Citizens Oversight Committee (Seats 1 through 13) with a framework where candidates qualify by demonstrating experience in any of the following areas:

- Experience in non-profit affordable housing development, preservation, Community Land Trusts, or community development corporations;
- Experience in workforce development, apprenticeship programs, or negotiating project labor agreements;
- Experience in tenant organizing, or advocacy work addressing the housing needs of tenants, seniors, and/or people with disabilities; or
- Lived experience as a tenant in a lower-income household, or as an individual who has experienced homelessness.

I FURTHER MOVE to amend Section 22.618.6 (d) 6. Language to include provisions for removal mirroring the Los Angeles City Charter Section 502 (d).
