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Comments for Public Posting: I am writing to voice my protest against the proposed project for building 68 units on Barham Blvd./Floyd Terrace. As a long time member of the Hollywood Knolls Community Club, I have been involved in numerous land use project reviews. The development of these units is farcical considering the huge negative impact on multiple fronts. My focus is on Barham Blvd. traffic. As an HKCC board member I was involved in an early 90's DOT traffic study along Barham Blvd. It was concluded, among other issues, Barham Blvd. experienced traffic use numbers equivalent to traffic on the Golden Gate Bridge. That was almost 30 years ago. At this point Barham is already significantly overused and any new construction would require at least one lane closure for probably one year. With all the expanded sound stages at Universal and Warner Bros. Studios, the impact would be daily grid lock. Staff at Fire Station 76 expressed serious concerns over accessibility to accidents along the Barham corridor.
