Comments for Public Posting: Re: Creation of Two Separate Council Files for Documents Related to ED1 Ordinance I'm writing to ask why a separate council file has been created for the ED1 Draft Ordinance. The motion in the original council file, CF 23-0623, contains the request for the creation of the Draft Ordinance. But for some reason, when the Draft Ordinance was posted in November of 2023, a new council file was created, CF 23-0623-S1.

The Draft Ordinance, Recommendation Report and Findings were all posted to the second council file, but at the same time, other pertinent documents were posted to the original council file, including a report on the effectiveness of ED1 streamlining, mixed-income options and staffing needs. Why are the various reports, all of them containing important information, being posted to two separate council files? And if the original motion asking for the Ordinance is in CF 23-0623, why wasn't the Draft Ordinance posted to that file? While it appears from the mailing list posted in CF 23-0623-S1 that interested parties received notice of the CPC's determination, numerous parties, including neighborhoods councils, are still posting comments on the ordinance to the original council file. The two council files should be consolidated so that interested parties can review all relevant documents, and all comments on this process can be posted in one place. Also, this would allow interested parties to receive notifications about all new postings, including notices re committee hearings, by subscribing to a single council file.
