

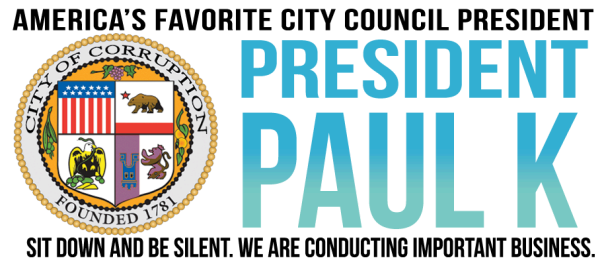

In celebration of former Council Member José Huizar's federal sentencing, America's Favorite City Council President is at it again to melodically make an official statement on current Council Member Curren D. Price Jr.'s alleged felonious behavior. DJ Krekorian has dropped a new soulful track and music video, **The New Ninth**, this time serving as a saxophone-infused critique on the litany of criminal charges against Price. The Council Member has been indicted and arraigned on felony corruption charges and yet he remains on the Los Angeles City Council. Angelenos need to ask themselves why this is. Who is complicit in keeping him in power and why?

The music video for this track explores the deeper damage caused by Price's actions and the tangled web behind them. It ponders the Council President's implicit support of Price by allowing him to continue to conduct "important business". It also explores the political backgrounds of those financially supporting Price's Legal Defense Fund. Those guilty of enabling Price need to realize they are just as responsible for the perpetuation of damage against the economically disadvantaged Angelenos of South Los Angeles as he is.

Hundreds of Angelenos have been displaced in Council District 9, the poorest area of Los Angeles, while Price focuses on enriching himself and his alleged wife [Del Richardson Price](#). How many across Los Angeles were displaced by Del Richardson & Associates? And how many of those displacements were approved by City Council actions that Price did not recuse himself from? Why is President Krekorian complicit in this by decimating public comment even as displaced and harassed renters cry out for help to an indifferent and incorrigible Council?

Price explosively described victims of the LAPD 27th Street fireworks detonation as "trying to game the system", which is especially galling given his alleged illegal attempts to enrich himself

via embezzlement, perjury, and conflict of interest - wouldn't that be him gaming the system at the expense of taxpayers?

Price will have you believe that the allegations being made against him are simple mistakes and misunderstandings or, alternatively, a witch hunt. This is hard to believe given the evidence. The Prices previously attempted to pull the same embezzlement scam in Inglewood for over \$22,000 and were rebuffed. Reports have been made that DDA Casey Higgins has presented an invalid marriage certificate from Price's HR file as evidence in his case. Council Member Price continued to refuse to recuse himself from Council votes that Delbra had a financial interest in even after the matter was addressed in the media. These actions paint a picture of a long history of intentional corruption.

Is governance reform even possible when the denizens of the Horseshoe are more beholden to special interests, their donors, and self-interest than they are to the Angelenos they purport to serve? Is this how you "serve the City well"?

All DJ Krekorian tracks feature samples from our elected officials, allowing their own words to create the lyrical soul of each song. As long as our City Officials fail to meet the governance crisis with serious change, DJ Krekorian will continue to produce slapping bangers that are as equally unserious. No Los Angeles politician will be safe from DJ Krekorian's acrid tracks.

DJ Krekorian's fourth track, **The New Ninth** lambasts the long unfolding corruption story in Los Angeles' Ninth Council District. **The New Ninth** features LA Press Club's 2023 Online Journalist of the Year Daniel Guss, Council Member Curren Price, and the First Lady of The New Ninth Delbra Richardson Price, as well as several members of the press and the public.

The video is dedicated in loving memory to [activist John Walsh](#), who passed in 2019 during the active process of his displacement by Del Richardson Price at Yucca and Argyle.
