**Comments for Public Posting:** A new railing can be seen as starting construction behind the temporary fence which is only a single railing prior to the motion being passed. The permanent fence / railing should restrict pedestrians on both sides in order to keep them on the trail and off the roadway. Given the current path next to the fence and pedestrian's behavior, a single railing will not resolve the safety risk. Removal of the signage "No pedestrian access beyond this point" without an alternative access solution in place has lead to significantly more pedestrians taking over the highway impeding traffic. Would suggest temporary restrictions or enforcement be utilized until there is a safe path.
