PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to replacing the temporary fencing on Mulholland Highway, beginning at Canyon Lake Drive and running along a portion of the Lake Hollywood Park perimeter east to Durand Drive, with a permanent option.

Recommendation for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Raman – Soto-Martinez):

INSTRUCT the Bureau of Engineering, with the assistance of the City Administrative Officer (CAO) and other departments as necessary, to report within 60 days with recommendations to replace the temporary fencing on Mulholland Highway, beginning at Canyon Lake Drive and running along a portion of the Lake Hollywood Park perimeter east to Durand Drive, with a permanent option to deter vehicles from stopping along this two-lane segment, to initiate a capital improvement project, and to identify funding for the fencing replacement.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the CAO nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.
