You are hereby notified that the Planning and Land Use Management (PLUM) Committee of the Los Angeles City Council will hold a public hearing in-person on **Tuesday, October 17, 2023** at approximately 2:00 P.M., or soon thereafter, in the John Ferraro Council Chamber, Room 340, City Hall, 200 North Spring Street, Los Angeles, CA 90012 (entrance on Main Street), to consider the following: Sustainable Communities Environmental Assessment, No. ENV-2022-1049-SCEA (SCEA), Mitigation Measures, Mitigation Monitoring and Report Program, and related California Environmental Quality Act findings; report from the Los Angeles City Planning Commission (LACPC); and, an Appeal filed by CREED LA c/o Aidan P. Marshall (Representative: Adams, Broadwell, Joseph & Cardozo), from the LACPC's determination in approving a SCEA as the environmental clearance for the demolition of an existing one-story storage building and the partial demolition and conversion of an existing historic one-story commercial building for the construction, use, and maintenance of a new 15-story residential building with 45 units, with six units reserved for Very Low Income households. The Project proposes to provide 36 vehicle parking spaces. The Project also involves a lot line adjustment for minor internal lot boundary adjustments, to be reviewed under a separate ministerial process; for the properties located at 6422 West Selma Avenue, and 1540 - 1552 North Wilcox Avenue.
