**DRAFT ORDINANCE ADDING SUBSECTION (f) TO SECTION 53.15.2 OF
ARTICLE 3, CHAPTER V OF THE LOS ANGELES MUNICIPAL CODE TO PROVIDE
A TEMPORARY MORATORIUM ON THE ISSUANCE OF NEW DOG BREEDING
PERMITS UNTIL THE DOG POPULATION IN THE CITY'S
ANIMAL SHELTERS IS REDUCED**

Honorable Members:

Pursuant to your request, this Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality. The draft ordinance adds Subsection (f) to Section 53.15.2 of Article 3, Chapter V of the Los Angeles Municipal Code to place an immediate temporary moratorium on the issuance of new dog breeding permits, which will lift when the three-month moving average of the daily inventory count of all dogs at the Department of Animal Services' (Department) animal shelters is equal to or less than 75 percent of the Department's total dog kennel capacity. As requested, the moratorium will not apply to the renewal of existing dog breeding permits.

The draft ordinance also specifies that the moratorium will thereafter be automatically reinstated whenever the three-month moving average of the daily inventory count of all dogs at the Department's shelters is more than 75 percent of the Department's total dog kennel capacity, and will lift when the three-month moving

average of the daily inventory count of all dogs at the Department's shelters is equal to or less than 75 percent of the Department's total dog kennel capacity.
