I MOVE that the matter of the Ad Hoc Committee on City Governance Reform Report relative to the proposed creation of a Charter Reform Commission and a ballot measure proposal for Ethics Commission Reform, Item 12 on today's Council Agenda (C.F. 23-1027), BE AMENDED as follows:

- Amend Recommendation #2 to add the following relative to the establishment of a Charter Reform Commission:

f. The Commission's deliberation of all matters related to the scope prescribed in Recommendation 2(a) will include a formally dedicated engagement process of the City's Neighborhood Councils, with the goal of achieving a 60 percent submission rate of Community Impact Statements.

- Amend Recommendation #5 to add the following language:

Prior to the commencement of any full or limited review, the Charter Reform Commission will also develop and present to the Council for approval an outreach and engagement plan to ensure the participation of: Community Based Organizations; Labor; Business Advocacy organizations; and community groups, including Community Councils, Parent Centers, Faith-based community, and local Non-Profit Organizations. The outreach and engagement plan must include a town hall event in each Council District, with all outreach and presentation materials available in multiple languages.
