I MOVE that the matter of the Ad Hoc Committee on City Governance Reform Committee Report relative to reports from the Department of City Planning, Port of Los Angeles, Personnel, Los Angeles World Airports, Neighborhood Empowerment, Board of Recreation and Park Commissioners, City Clerk, Board of Public Works, Los Angeles Department of Water and Power, City Attorney, and City Administrative Officer regarding Charter reform recommendations, Item 27 on today's Council agenda (Council File 23-1027), BE AMENDED to add the following new recommendation:

**Attachment A - Proposed Charter Amendments for November 2024  
New Items - Sections 242 and 245**

**Section 242 - Conduct of Business.**


The Council shall be the sole judge of the election and qualification of its members. Meetings and records of the proceedings of the Council and of the committees of the Council shall be open to the public, except that closed sessions may be held as permitted by law. The Council shall have the exclusive power to organize its business, prescribe the rules of its proceedings and preserve order at its meetings, subject to the following:


- (a) The Council shall hold regular meetings **weekly** ~~at least three days each week~~. Meetings may be held in City Hall or elsewhere in the City. By resolution, the Council may establish periods during which the Council or its committees will be in recess. The Council and its committees may also each hold special meetings with proper notice.

**Section 245 - City Council Veto of Board Actions**

Actions of boards of commissioners shall become final at the expiration of two meeting days or **14 calendar days**, whichever is greater, ~~the next five meeting days of the Council~~ during which the Council has convened in regular session, unless the Council acts within that time by two-thirds vote to bring the action before it or to waive review of the action, except that as to any action of the Board of Police Commissioners regarding the removal of the Chief of Police, the time period within which the Council may act before the action of the Board shall become final shall be three meeting dates or **twenty one calendar days**, whichever is greater, ~~ten meeting days~~ during which the Council has convened in regular session.
