A Neighborhood Council Community Impact Statement (CIS) has been successfully submitted to your Commission or City Council. We provided information below about CISs and attached a copy of the CIS.

We encourage you to reach out to the Community Impact Statement Filer to acknowledge receipt and if this Community Impact Statement will be scheduled at a future meeting. Neighborhood Council board members are volunteers and it would be helpful if they received confirmation that you received their CIS.

The CIS process was enabled by the Los Angeles Administrative Code §Section 22.819. It provides that, "a Neighborhood Council may take a formal position on a matter by way of a Community Impact Statement (CIS) or written resolution." NCs representatives also testify before City Boards and Commissions on the item related to their CIS. If the Neighborhood Council chooses to do so, the Neighborhood Council representative must provide the Commission with a copy of the CIS or resolution sufficiently in advance for review, possible inclusion on the agenda, and posting on the Commission's website. Any information you can provide related to your agenda setting schedule is helpful to share with the NC.

If the CIS or resolution pertains to a matter *listed on the Commission's agenda*, during the time the matter is heard, the designated Neighborhood Council representative should be given an opportunity to present the Neighborhood Council's formal position. We encourage becoming familiar with the City Council's rules on the subject. At the Chair's discretion, the Neighborhood Council representative may be asked to have a seat at the table (or equivalent for a virtual meeting) typically reserved for City staff and may provide the Neighborhood Council representative more time than allotted to members of the general public. They are also permitted up to five (5) minutes of time to address the legislative body. If the CIS or resolution pertains to a matter *not listed on the agenda*, the designated Neighborhood Council representative may speak during General Public Comments.

Summary: Motion passed by 2/3 of the 21 GWNC Board Seats by a vote of 14-2-4 on 11/8/2023: "The GWNC, reflecting its desire for higher community participation and the avoidance of the possible transmission of disease, will hold the first regular monthly board meeting each quarter in person; and will hold its second and third regular board meetings each quarter virtually; furthermore, the GWNC may, at the discretion of the President or by a simple majority vote of the Board, occasionally substitute a virtual meeting for an in-person meeting or vice-versa; and the GWNC President, or in President's absence, the GWNC Vice President may call Special Meetings of the Board as needed and may call for such meetings to be held virtually or in-person, at their discretion; and the GWNC will file a Community Impact Statement reflecting this motion." Subsequent motion, also adopted on November 8, 2023 by a vote of 20-0-0: "If a GWNC

committee has not yet voted its preference for regular or virtual meetings, or a combination thereof, and until said committee has taken such a vote and the Board has voted its concurrence, the Chairperson of said committee may call its Regular and Special meetings as in-person or virtual, as they see fit.“

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
