This strip that runs parallel to the TUJUNGA RIVER WASH PARK and the GREAT WALL is used as a drag race strip by many car AND motorcycle drivers at all hours of the day and night, some reaching approximate speeds of 80 mph at times... We DESPERATELY need these devices along this section of the street. I am surprised this part of the Avenue is not already designated for this (per maps), as we have multiple accidents (including a fatality about 10 years ago) every year. Many of us in these buildings make reports to our Council people and the LAPD each time this happens. And, we have made a request for a controlled crosswalk at the corner of Hatteras for safer crossing over to the walking loop along this park, but to no avail thus far... It would be a tragic oversight if this strip of COLDWATER CANYON gets overlooked just at this time when something can be implemented to reverse these trends.
