Dear Members of the Transportation Committee,

On behalf of the Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD), District staff have reviewed the report and the list of 125 locations proposed for inclusion in the City of Los Angeles Speed Safety System Pilot Program (Item 12, CF 23-1168). Based on this review, and considering traffic safety concerns across LAUSD's four regions, we respectfully submit the following school sites for consideration in the pilot program:

- **Arroyo Seco Museum Science Magnet (CD1):** Drivers frequently exceed posted speed limits in front of the school. The roadway has a downhill slope with curves, limited visibility, and a wide street configuration, creating unsafe conditions for students, families, and staff.
- **Canyon Elementary School (CD11):** It is requested that a speed safety camera be placed at the intersection of Entrada Drive and Amalfi Drive. Vehicles routinely disregard stop signs and accelerate through the intersection.

LAUSD appreciates the opportunity to provide input and looks forward to continued communication and collaboration as the City enhances traffic safety around school communities. We are happy to further discuss our recommendations if you have any questions, and please feel free to forward this information to the appropriate staff member.
