

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the low-income payment diversion program as part of the Speed Safety System Pilot Program.

Recommendation for Council action:

NOTE and FILE the Department of Transportation (DOT) report dated July 8, 2026, relative to the resources needed to implement the required low-income payment diversion program as part of the speed safety system pilot program, inasmuch as it is for information only and no action is required.

Summary:

On August 12, 2026, your Transportation Committee considered a July 8, 2026 DOT report relative to the low-income payment diversion program as part of the Speed Safety System Pilot Program. According to the report, Assembly Bill 645 authorizes the implementation of speed safety system pilot programs and requires a diversion program for indigent speed safety system violation recipients to perform community service in lieu of paying the penalty for the violation. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend noting and filing the DOT report. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
