In the long term, appointees to the Board of Neighborhood Commissioners should have a formal feedback process wherein the Neighborhood Councils can provide input in who represents us and our stakeholders.

current nominee be withdrawn until such time that Neighborhood Councils have ample opportunity to provide this feedback.
