**Comments for Public Posting:** Appointments to the Board of Neighborhood Commissioners (BONC) need to be vetted by the Neighborhood Councils and Alliances that they represent. We are elected City officials representing our communities and are advisory bodies to the City Council and Mayor -- we should get a say in who represents us on BONC. Furthermore, I believe that based on his past actions Mr. Nadel would be a toxic choice to represent the West LA Neighborhood Councils on the Board of Neighborhood Commissioners and that the affected Neighborhood Councils and alliances should be given a chance to have their voices heard on this appointment. I request that this nomination be withdrawn until such time that the NCs have had ample time to give input. In the long term, appointees to the Board of Neighborhood Commissioners should have a formal feedback process wherein the Neighborhood Councils can provide input in who represents us and our stakeholders. Since commission appointments are time restricted, community outreach should be started before a nomination is made.
