However, in 2019 it became occupied by a 100 tent encampment, which completely cut off full community use of this valuable asset. In 2020, under the leadership of Mike Bonin, the city implemented it's inaugural Encampments to Homes project along this path, providing housing and services to all the individuals in the encampment. Since then, the neighborhood has worked very closely with CD-11, now under the leadership of Traci Park, to envision a beautifully refurbished and nature-filled walking/running path for the community in this space. This project is unique in that it was fully supported by both the previous CD-11 administration and the current one. The community is very excited about being able to use this space safely again and see this project to completion, but in order to keep it open for recreational use by all members of the community, it is imperative that 41.18 protection is applied to cement the success of the original 2020 Encampments to Homes project and keep the path encampment free.
