

The City of Los Angeles offers a reward payable at the discretion of the City Council to one or more persons in the sum or sums up to an aggregate maximum total sum of \$50,000 for information leading to the identification and apprehension of the person or persons responsible for the DEATH OF FRANCISCO GARCIA, in the city of Los Angeles On January 12, 2024, at approximately 11:45 p.m., a white colored pickup truck was heading northbound on San Fernando Road approaching Montague Street driving in the southbound lanes. As the pickup truck proceeded north, Francisco Garcia was crossing the street and was struck by the pickup truck. During the collision, Mr. Garcia was thrown onto the northbound lane of San Fernando Road. A second vehicle, a gray SUV proceeding northbound struck Mr. Garcia, and he was propelled onto the southbound lane where a third vehicle, a silver sedan heading southbound, struck him. Mr. Garcia later succumbed to his injuries. The driver of the white color pickup truck, gray SUV, and silver sedan all failed to stop, identify themselves, and render aid as required by law. Detectives are continuing to investigate this crime but have not been able to identify any leads. The detectives believe a reward may compel member of the public to provide information on the persons responsible for this crime. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles; therefore, it is appropriate for the City of Los Angeles to offer a reward for information leading to the identification, apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for this crime. Unless withdrawn or paid by City Council action, this offer of reward shall terminate on, and have no effect after, March 27, 2025. AVISO DE RECOMPENSA DE \$50,000

La Ciudad de Los Angeles ofrece una recompensa pagadera a la discreción del Concejo de la Ciudad a una o más personas por la suma o hasta una cantidad en conjunto de \$50,000 por información que conduzca a la identificación y detención de la persona o personas responsables por la MUERTE DE FRANCISCO GARCÍA, en la ciudad de Los Angeles. El 12 de enero de 2024, aproximadamente a las 11:45 p.m., una

camioneta de color blanco se dirigía hacia el norte en San Fernando Road acercándose a Montague Street conduciendo en los carriles hacia el sur. Mientras la camioneta se dirigía hacia el norte, Francisco García estaba cruzando la calle y fue impactado por la camioneta. Durante la colisión, el Sr. García fue arrojado al carril norte de San Fernando Road. Un segundo vehículo, una SUV gris que circulaba en dirección norte, golpeó al Sr. García y salió despedido hacia el carril sur, donde lo golpeó un tercer vehículo, un sedán plateado que circulaba en dirección sur. El Sr. García sucumbió a sus heridas. El conductor de la camioneta color blanco, la SUV gris y el sedán plateado no se detuvieron, ni se identificaron ni presaron auxilio según lo exige la ley. Los detectives continúan investigando este crimen, pero no han podido identificar ninguna pista. Los detectives creen que una recompensa puede obligar a los miembros del público a proporcionar información sobre las personas responsables de este crimen. La persona o personas responsables de este crimen representa una amenaza constante para la seguridad de la gente de Los Angeles; por lo tanto, es apropiado que la Ciudad de Los Angeles ofrezca una recompensa por la información que conduzca a la identificación, aprehensión y condena de la persona o personas responsables de este crimen.
