While I fully support the traffic study to identify quantitative impacts of the project, I wholeheartedly oppose the gondola (Los Angeles Aerial Rapid Transit) project. The gondola would negatively impact the residents on route, specifically at Llewellyn where I live. Those seeking to ride the gondola would need to find a place to park near the loading tower, and therefore would create massive traffic and parking issues for the Residents all around LA Historic Park. The construction and operation of the gondola system will likely disrupt local ecosystems, increase pollution, and compromise the natural beauty of our landscape. Additionally, the influx of visitors attracted by this new infrastructure is expected to intensify traffic congestion on already crowded roads, causing inconvenience for residents and straining local resources. While private investment may reduce upfront costs, the long-term impact on our community's environment and quality of life is substantial. I urge the county to reconsider this project and prioritize sustainable and community-focused solutions such as expanded Dodger Stadium Express shuttles (similar to the Hollywood Bowl shuttle system).
